

LANDSCAPE REPORT

November 2007

Since Nov. 2006 many landscape issues have been addressed.

- 1- Formosa Koa between I&H and K&J have been cut back--should be maintained yearly.
- 2- Be-Stills at paddle temiis court cut way back to promote new growth and get their branches out of tree canopy above resulting in a cleaner look.
- 3- Area behind Q cleaned up and dead WilliWilli shrubs removed.
- 4- Hillside area below P and above 0 cleaned out. Invasive vining plants removed resulting in stone wall and large attractive boulders being exposed.
- 5- Cut Oleander around A buildings garbage dump to promote new filler growth.
- 6- Cleaned fruit from Coconut Palms.
- 7- Removed 2 dead WilliWilli trees from lanai side of D building.
- 8- Cleaned out Monkey Pod canopy of dead wood.
- 9- Cut back branches from roofs.
- 10- Pulled out numerous volunteer plants---Be-Stills are the biggest reseeder.
- 11- Suckers removed from trees on a regular basis.
- 12- To promote a cleaner look we are having the gardeners keep plants cut back from walkways, weeds pulled , dead branches picked up from ground, and turkey droppings scraped up.
- 14- Bougainvillea hedge along gully wall thinned and cut back.

We have gotten estimates for diseased tree removal. Budget allowing, we would like to start removal of diseased Eucalyptus in 2008.

Remember there is a recommended plant list if you are making a request. It is kept in the Landscape binder in the office.
